*Temporary Closure
Forest Roads and Trails*

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited on roads as described in this order, all within the Bridger-Teton National Forest.

1. Using a motor vehicle on any road. **36 CFR 261.54 (a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS DESCRIBED:

South Fork Spread Creek Road 30100 from its junction of Flagstaff Road 30160 to Leidy Lake.

The roads described above are located within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Blackrock Ranger District, Bridger-Teton National Forest, Teton County, Wyoming.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to protect public safety. The road bed experienced significant damage created by spring runoff and is impassable due to landslides and washouts.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until August 31, 2018 or rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals, and \$10,000.00 for organizations and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
3. Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
